IMPORTANT – READ CAREFULLY

THIS BUILDING WILL BE FUMIGATED WITH LETHAL GASES ON THE DATE(S) INDICATED ABOVE. ALL PERSONS AND ANIMALS MUST VACATE THE PREMISES ON OR BEFORE THE ARRIVAL OF THE FUMIGATION CREW.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES CAN ANYONE ENTER THE BUILDING UNTIL THE FUMIGATION COMPANY’S NOTICE IS POSTED GIVING THE TIME AND DATE FOR SAFE RE-ENTRY.

“State law requires that you be given the following information: CAUTION-PESTICIDES ARE TOXIC CHEMICALS. Structural pest control companies are registered and regulated by the Structural Pest Control Board, and apply pesticides which are registered and approved for use by the California Department of Pesticide Regulation and the United States Environmental Protection Agency. Registration is granted when the State finds that based on existing scientific evidence there are no appreciable risks if proper use conditions are followed or that the risks are outweighed by the benefits. The degree of risk depends upon the degree of exposure, so exposure should be minimized.”

If within 24 hours you experience symptoms of dizziness, headache, nausea, reduced awareness, slowed movement, garbled speech or difficulty in breathing, leave the structure immediately and seek attention by contacting your physician or Poison Control Center (800) 876-4766 and notify your pest control company. The warning agent, chloropicrin, can cause symptoms of tearing, respiratory distress and vomiting. Entry into the space during fumigation can be fatal.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND SIGNATURE REQUIRED ON PAGE TWO

TERMS, CONDITIONS, AND LIABILITIES

- A. Our crew must fumigate several structures in various locations each day. Therefore, any time of the day for the fumigation to be scheduled will be an approximate time only.
- B. We do not wish to inconvenience you by having you wait for our arrival on the date of the fumigation. When you decide on a date, talk it over with your termite inspector, make arrangements with regard to keys and leave with the assurance that your building will be properly fumigated and will be safe for your return. IN CASE OF RAIN OR STRONG WINDS, THE JOB MAY HAVE TO BE POSTPONED TO A LATER DATE. BE SURE AND LEAVE AN EMERGENCY PHONE NUMBER WHERE YOU CAN BE REACHED. IF FORCIBLE ENTRY IS NECESSARY, THE FUMIGATOR WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR REPAIRS.

WARNING FOR POTENTIAL LANDSCAPE DAMAGE

- C. Where climbing plants, fences, trellises and vines must be detached from the building and the homeowner/occupant has not done this; any damage will not be our liability. BUGMASTERS may cause damage to plants within 18” of the exterior perimeter of the structure to be fumigated. The owner, tenant or occupant should soak the foundation outward the evening before the fumigation. All plant growth should be cut back at least 12” from the structure to be fumigated.

WARNING FOR EXPECTED ROOF DAMAGE

- D. THE ROOF SURFACE AND PERIMETER AREAS OF THE BUILDING MUST BE WALKED ON AND DAMAGE MAY/WILL OCCUR. ALTHOUGH CARE WILL BE EXERCISED, NEITHER THIS COMPANY, NOR ITS LICENSED FUMIGATOR WILL ASSUME ANY LIABILITY FOR SUCH DAMAGE OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGE THAT MAY/WILL OCCUR to the roof coverings or materials, aerial antennae and areas below same, gutters, electrical wiring, patio and awning covers, solar heating panels or related plumbing, or chimneys.
- E. IN CASE OF TILE ROOFS THERE WILL ALWAYS BE DAMAGE ALTHOUGH CARE WILL BE EXERCISED; NEITHER THIS COMPANY NOR ITS LICENSED FUMIGATOR WILL ASSUME AND LIABILITY FOR SUCH DAMAGE.

WARNING FOR STUCCO/PAINT DAMAGE

- F. Fumigations where masking or painter’s tape is used, and where the painted surface is old or oxidized may result in some peeling paint. Some paint surfaces will chip or peel if the undercoating was not properly applied, even though these surfaces appear to be in good condition. Tape adhesive may be present after the use of such tape. NEITHER THIS COMPANY NOR ITS LICENSED FUMIGATOR WILL ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR SUCH DAMAGE.

SECURITY

- G. WE DO NOT PROVIDE ON-SITE SECURITY DURING THE FUMIGATION PROCEDURES OR AFTER THE TENTS OR SEALS ARE REMOVED, and as such our insurance does not cover malicious vandalism, theft (screened windows may be left partially open and unlocked for ventilation of the building). If the homeowner or occupant wishes such security, same would be his/her additional expense for such arrangements and is not the liability of the company or the fumigation licensee.

NATURAL GAS SERVICE

- H. YOUR GAS SERVICE WILL BE TURNED OFF BY THE GAS COMPANY THE MORNING OF THE DAY OF THE FUMIGATION. THE JOB WILL COMMENCE SOMETIME AFTER THE GAS HAS BEEN TURNED OFF. THE HOMEOWNER/OCCUPANT MUST BE SURE THAT ACCESS TO THE GAS METER IS MADE AVAILABLE BEFORE 7:00 A.M. ON THE DAY OF THE FUMIGATION. FAILURE TO HAVE ACCESS WILL RESULT IN THE JOB BEING CANCELLED OR POSTPONED FOR A LATER DATE AND TRIP CHARGES MAY APPLY. JOBS THAT ARE SCHEDULED FOR SATURDAYS OR HOLIDAY SERVICE WILL BE SCHEDULED TO BE TURNED OFF THE WORKING DAY BEFORE THE FUMIGATION. THE HOMEOWNER/OCCUPANT WILL NEED TO CALL THE GAS COMPANY AT LEAST ONE DAY BEFORE THE JOB IS COMPLETED/CERTIFIED TO SCHEDULE SERVICE TO BE RESTORED. Old gas and water pipes may be damaged during the fumigation. We are not responsible for such damage. We also assume no responsibility for damage resulting from faulty gas meters. We are not responsible for damage to old faulty furnaces and water heaters resulting from re-lighting procedures.

MOBILE HOMES

- I. Due to the fragile nature in which mobile homes are constructed, some damage may occur to carports, roofs, rails, siding, or awnings. Although care will be taken, we can assume no responsibility for damage to these areas.

REGULATIONS

- J. All exterior doors (including the water heater cabinet) to the building being fumigated must be lockable. If no hasp or other interior/exterior locking device exists, state law requires nailing these door shut. If the homeowner or his/her agent has not provided adequate locks, and nailing is performed by the fumigation licensee, we will assume no liability for damage to the door or door jamb. Nailing or locking is required to keep out any person such as a small child from being accidentally trapped inside. Cars inside structures must be completely opened or removed.
- K. BY FEDERAL AND STATE LAW, and as indicated by the label, the following items MUST be removed before the fumigation with any fumigant:
 - 1) Persons, plants, baby mattresses, and pets (including fish) must be removed from the structure and yard of the property to be fumigated prior to the arrival the crew. Please do not allow cats to roam outside.
 - 2) Mattresses completely enveloped in waterproof covers must have the covers completely removed. BABY MATTRESSES MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE STRUCTURE.
 - 3) Cars, vehicles, boats, RV units, and walk-in safes that have locked doors, trunks, hoods, or compartments that lock must be removed or unlocked during the fumigation.
- L. Bag or remove all foods and medications not sealed in glass or metal containers. This includes anything that will be orally ingested such as candy and gum. It also includes food in freezers and refrigerators. Use NYLOFUME bags ONLY. See the attached instruction sheet. UNBAGGED OR IMPROPERLY BAGGED/SEALED FOOD WILL BE BAGGED OR SEALED AT AN ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF \$25.00 TO \$100.00 (PER UNIT). Note: sulfuryl fluoride is not registered for fumigation of prepared foodstuff. Therefore, food and medicine must be removed or bagged as required by law.

LIMITED WARRANTY

- M. If a redo for fumigation is recommended, **BUGMASTERS** will not be responsible for lodging, meals, or preparation of the fumigation. It is at the discretion of **BUGMASTERS** whether a redo constitutes local treatment or fumigation.

IN SIGNING, I HEREBY WAIVE, RELEASE, AND DISCHARGE BUGMASTERS AND THE PRIME CONTRACTOR FROM ANY AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY AND LIABILITY FROM ANY PROPERTY DAMAGE AS DESCRIBED IN A THROUGH M THAT BUGMASTERS MAY CAUSE DURING THE FUMIGATION PROCESS AND ANY CONSEQUENTIAL PROPERTY DAMAGE WHICH MAY DEVELOP AS A RESULT OF THE FUMIGATION PROCESS.

FUMIGATION FACTS CHECKLIST

- THE GAS COMPANY WILL ARRIVE BETWEEN 7AM TO 12PM**
Any locked gates must be open or the gas technician will not shut off your gas. This will delay your fumigation. Our fumigation crew will arrive between the hours of 10AM to 5PM. If requested, we can text or call you approximately one hour before the crew arrives at your property. If your fumigation is scheduled for a Saturday start, your gas will be turned off the day before between 12PM to 5PM.
- MAKE SURE YOU'VE SCHEDULED YOUR GAS TURN ON**
It is the responsibility of the homeowner to schedule a gas turn-on appointment. The gas company can be reached at (877) 238-0092. We recommended calling the gas company 48 hours in advance of the desired date to be scheduled. Long Beach residents contact Long Beach Gas (562) 570-2000
- ALL FOOD IS PREPARED AND STORED IN NYLOFUME BAGS**
To prepare for fumigation please refer to the fumigation instructions notice. Make sure all food is prepared in the provided nylofume bags. Any food not properly prepared will have to be thrown away. Twenty bags are included in your fumigation estimate . Additional bags are available at \$1 per bag.
- KEEP ELECTRICITY TURNED ON AT THE PROPERTY**
The fumigation crew will need active electrical power at the property during the whole fumigation process. This is needed to power the fans and circulate the air to complete the aeration of the property. If power is not active it will delay the fumigation.
- FUMIGATION OVER THE WEEKEND - NO SUNDAYS**
Bugmasters does not work on Sundays. If your fumigation begins on a Friday or Saturday an extra night out of the home will be needed to complete the process. Jobs that start on Friday are finished Monday. Jobs that start on Saturday are finished on Tuesday.
- REMOVE VALUABLES, UNLOCK CABINETS / CLOSETS**
During the fumigation any cabinet drawers / closets / storage cabinets etc. will need to be opened to prevent gas "pocketing" and ensure home will be safe for re-entry. Due to recent increases of crime in Southern California we recommend any personal valuables or important documentation be removed from the home prior to fumigation. If you live in an area susceptible to burglary, we recommend contacting a security patrol service.
- FUMIGATION CERTIFICATION TIMES 8AM TO 12PM**
On the last day of fumigation, the tent will be removed and home will be certified for re-entry. A notice will be posted on the front door of the property that certifies the home is ready. If requested, we can text you approximately one hour before the crew arrives at your property.
- NO CLEANING OR AIRING OUT REQUIRED**
The fumigant gas does not leave any residual. It is not necessary to wipe down or wash any counter-tops, dishes, laundry etc. There is no need to air out the property any additional time. Once residence is certified for re-entry it is completely safe for anyone to enter the property.
